Running order will be in order of entry and sent to competitors in advance of the trial. Trial volunteers registered as volunteers prior to May 10, 2025, will be in the first group for each level, in order of entry. Bitches in heat will run last.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Please check-in with the Trial Secretary upon your arrival to the trial site and present each dog's registration card. Check-in is a minimum of one hour before your estimated judges briefing time for your level.

This titling event is being held under the rules of the Sporting Detection Dogs Association. Open to all breeds & mixed breeds. Dogs **must** be registered with the SDDA and be over six (6) months of age to enter this trial. Please advise us in advance if you will be bringing a bitch in season.

Dogs must be always under control. This is public and private property so please keep barking to a minimum, pick up after your dog(s) promptly and note your dog **must be** on leash when not crated or in the search areas. Benching will be from vehicles. Any handler displaying inhumane or aggressive treatment of any dog, the public or other handler (physically or verbally) will be asked to leave the premises without refund. All dogs must be on a flat collar or harness in the search area. Leashes must be fabric or leather of any length in the search area.

Handler/Dog Teams may enter one or all components. All three (3) components (Container, Interior, Exterior) must be successfully completed (qualifying scores earned) to earn a title. It is not necessary to complete all three on the same day, however, the honourific SP (Special designation) will be added to the title of any dog who completes the three components on the same day at the same trial. Except for Elite, all three (3) components must be completed in the same trial to title.



**Training and/or unofficial use of odour is strictly prohibited on the trial grounds.
This includes your vehicle, parking areas, etc.**

FEES: **Games:** \$20.00 per entry (Distance, Speed, Aerial) Team \$15.00 per dog.
Regular trial: \$35.00 per component entered or \$100.00 for all three components with the same dog.

ENTRIES: Based on first come first served basis.
Limited to one dog per level per owner/handler for each Regular Trial Day. Dogs will be initially limited to three (3) components per day on Saturday and Sunday. If there is room, Dogs will then, on a first come first served basis, be allowed to enter additional components.
This is being done to allow as many teams as possible to compete.

Please note: The online registration form will not allow an entry to be submitted if you do not have a valid SDDA Registered Participant Number until the registration form is open to the general public.

ENTRY CONFIRMATION: Entries are to be submitted by online form.
Confirmations will be e-mailed once entries have been processed.
Payment is due once confirmation e-mail has been sent. Payment must be sent within 72 hours of receiving a confirmation e-mail or your space will be released.
If the trial fills a wait list will be started.

AWARDS: Qualifying ribbons will be presented per component and rosettes for new titles.

REFRESHMENTS: Coffee/ tea/ water will be provided, bring your own lunch.

MOVE-UPS: Move ups will be allowed time permitting. There will be limited move-ups for Sunday, because of time restrictions, please see the trial secretary before the end of the trial Saturday.
If you need to move a dog up after your entry has been submitted advise us as soon as possible before the trial start date. We will not be able to accommodate multiple changes to your entries after running schedules have been compiled and sent out.

COMPETITORS: Submission of your entry acknowledges that you have reviewed the rules and regulations in the Master Rule Book on the SDDA site. (www.sdda.ca)

CRATING: Be prepared to bench from your vehicle. There will be **NO** indoor crating.
